Students will present their summer research projects in an interactive virtual program designed to showcase their accomplishments.

We anticipate the participation of 20-30 students, depending on the size of this year's O'Brien Center summer research programs. O'Brien Center leaders, other Center investigators and trainees (including from CAIRIBU P20 Exploratory Centers and K12 Programs), NIDDK Program Officers, and students' family and friends will be invited.

NOTE: This program is in development and will be guided by CAIRIBU O'Brien Center Leaders, Jill Macoska, PhD and James Brooks, MD. The format below is based on last summer's student research jamboree.

- 1) Introduction to burden of benign GU disease in society (5 min, O'Brien Center PI)
- 2) Introduction to research in benign GU (5 min, O'Brien Center PI)
- 3) Round-robin student presentations (e.g., 10 at a time), each group followed by time for discussion and Q&A in virtual breakout rooms
- 4) Concluding Remarks (5 min, O'Brien Center PI)
